2003-2004 USPA BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTIONS

This is your official ballot for the 2003-2004 USPA Board of Directors elections. In this election, you will be electing eight (8) National Directors and one (1) Regional Director for the region in which you currently reside. Those elected will serve for the next two years.

All ballots must be received at USPA Headquarters no later than 5 p.m. EST December 31, 2002. Only current USPA regular individual members (not temporary individual members) are eligible to vote, and each member can vote only once.

How to Vote

You may vote for as many as eight (8) USPA National Directors. Mark your ballot with an "X" in the column next to the candidate's name. You aren't required to vote for a total of eight; you may vote for fewer than eight if you choose.

You may write in the name of any candidate(s) for National Director not listed on the ballot. However, a write-in vote counts as one of the eight votes. Voting for more than eight National Directors will invalidate that section of your ballot.

When voting for Regional Directors, you may vote for only one (1) candidate who resides in the region in which you live, according to current USPA records. Mark your ballot with an "X" in the column next to the candidate's name. Voting for candidates outside of your region will invalidate that section of your ballot.

The map below shows a regional breakdown by the first three digits of each zip code. USPA members in a foreign country may vote for any one (1) Regional Director candidate.

You may also write in the name of any candidate for Regional Director not listed on the ballot, but that person must reside in your region. Remember, you may vote for only one Regional Director candidate. USPA members who do not reside in the U.S. may vote for any one eligible person as a Regional Director and up to eight National Directors.

Write-in candidates may be for either National or Regional Director, but the same individual cannot be voted for both. This will invalidate your entire ballot.


The Deadline

All ballots must be received at USPA Headquarters, 1440 Duke St., Alexandria, VA 22314, no later than 5 p.m. EST December 31, 2002. Any ballots received after this date will be marked invalid.

Mark your selections clearly, and be sure the names of any write-in candidates are legible and spelled correctly.

Each ballot must be marked and signed by the voter in original handwriting. Although photocopies of this ballot are acceptable, each must still be **marked and signed by the voting member**. Faxes or pre-marked ballots are not acceptable. Mail your ballot in today. Be counted. Vote!
